March 2006 Newsletter

Our second meeting for the 2006 season will be held on Thursday March 2nd at 7pm at the American Legion Post 88, 2663 Halls Mill Road (the usual place). You might want to get there a bit early ;-)

Now into our tenth year, the ACFA continues to grow in membership and accomplishments. Be a part of it! Jason Miller will speak about new developments with Conoco's proposed 'Open Loop' LNG terminal just off the Alabama coast. Our first tournament of the 2006 season will be Saturday March 25th

Speckled Trout, White Trout, Sheepshead and Ground Mullet are the category fish. You can launch and fish anywhere in Alabama waters. Tournament times are 5am to 5pm; weigh-in is from 2pm-5pm at the American Legion Post 250 on Dauphin Island Parkway (next to the Family Dollar Store near Greer's in the Fowl River area). Weigh Master Pat Hughes will be set up behind the building and ACFA members are asked to park their vehicles and fishing rigs in the large parking lot behind the building. Restrooms and a beverage bar are located inside the main building and if you are so inclined, we ask that you purchase from the Post if you can. Also please offer any unneeded fish to the Post as they utilize the ACFA as one source of fish for the fish fries they hold for disabled vets throughout the year.

And as has become our recent custom, ACFA will be providing food (of some nature) at the weigh-ins for members and guests. Our Food Chairman Randy Wiscaver will announce what's on the menu at the March meeting.

12 awards and Tournament Points will be up for grabs, but your dues **MUST** be paid prior to tournament day to be eligible. Copies of the ACFA Tournament Rules will be available at the March meeting (or on our website).
