By nearly 200 members and guests who attended the 11th Annual ACFA Awards Banquet held Saturday evening December 8, 2007. Over 60 awards and trophies were given out and mass quantities of delicious HOT, catered food and sides from Catalina Seafood were consumed along with numerous "scrumptious" desserts contributed by the attending members. It was another great ACFA party, and if you missed it, then you REALLY missed it! But the focus of the evening was the award presentations that followed.

Our 2007 Big Fish Champions were:

Flounder: Louis Felis 5.48#, 2nd Kyle Mitternacht, 3rd Sam Clark III, 4th Rick Yeend, 5th place Dane Tomberlin

Spanish Mackerel: 1st and 5th place Bekki Ludlam (L) 4.35#, 2nd Don Ludlam, 3rd Dane Tomberlin, 4th place Terry Quint

Ground Mullet: Brittney Howle (J) 1.50#, 2nd Jimmy Quint, 3rd and 4th place Daniel Ford, 5th place David Hare

Speckled Trout: Chris Massey 7.40#, 2nd Kelly Fulmer, 3rd Tom Duncan, 4th Bill Midgette, 5th place Bill Robinson

Redfish: Vince Hawkins 7.40#, 2nd Richard Rutland (N), 3rd Judy Smith (L), 4th Mutt Burke, and 5th place John Burke

White Trout: Vicki Foster (L) 3.15# *, 2nd and 3rd Mike Foster, 4th Patric Garmeson, and 5th place Adam Barker (N)

All the overall winners in the yearlong Big Fish Contest are assigned points based on the number and place of fish they had in the final 2007 Big Fish Contest results. We refer to this as the Big Fish Championship. Based on these point totals 3rd place went to Mike Foster, 2nd place Chris Massey, and **the 2007 Big Fish Championship was awarded to Kyle Mitternacht.**

In addition we recognized the accomplishments of club members who consistently placed in our monthly tournaments by their standings in accumulated point totals at the end of the competition season.

Mutt Burke was 5th place, Steve O'Dell (N) 4th place, Henry Nall, Chris Massey and Belinda Smith (L) tied for 3rd place, Rick Tourne and David Hare tied for 2nd place and **our 2007 Tournament co-Champions were Bill Midgette, Mike Foster and Patric Garmeson.**

An overall champion is chosen by a complex mathematical equation in which we compare each individual's rank in the Big Fish Contest and Tournament point totals.

By virtue of that, our coveted **2007 Master Angler Trophy was awarded to Mike Foster.**

We use the same formula to select the overall lady and junior anglers too. Lending equal weight to the Tournament and Big Fish Contest.

So the **2007 ACFA Lady Angler Trophy went to Bekki Ludlam** and the **2006 Junior Angler Trophy was awarded to Brittney Howle.**

The "Founder's Award" is another coveted trophy. Each year it is presented by Mike Thompson to the individual who is considered to have advanced the club by giving time and effort beyond expectations or job description. For his work in making the pre-meeting Mini-Seminar Series a resounding success along with promoting fish tagging coupled with catch & release, the 2007 Founder's Award went to Joe Sirmon.

A very important part of the success of the ACFA is the support of the club by individuals, businesses and organizations who help make it all possible. At the end of each year the club tries to recognize (albeit in a small way) the most deserving of them for their contributions with a plaque of recognition. In 2007, the ACFA recognized **Post 250, The American Legion** (tournament weigh in site), **Scott's Landing** (Speckled Trout Challenge and Causeway Classic weigh in site), **Grady Marine** (financial support throughout the year), **Charlie Crawford and Souther-N-Bama Bait & Tackle** (Big Fish Contest plaques and monthly door prizes). Thanks again Charlie!

The last award of the evening was the **Grand Attendance Prize** drawing (an ice chest filled with lures and other 'goodies' worth in excess of \$700). About 25 members qualified for the drawing (by attending at least 8 of the 10 regular monthly club meetings).

ACFA Rule of 200+

Now in our 12th year, the ACFA has maintained membership numbers of well over 200 for the past few years! In order to try and keep pace with the club's phenomenal growth, and to offer THE MOST opportunities for participation and awards back to the members, the 2008 officers voted unanimously to add an additional Tournament (in November). This to complement the great fall fishing we experience at that time. And as a conservational consideration we will add a CPR (Catch, Photograph & Release) contest that will run parallel to the year long Big Fish Contest. The difference is it is strictly **for speckled trout that are released alive after being measured and photographed.**

To enter the contest, all a member has to do is submit a photograph (paper or digital) of a speckled trout that adequately shows the true length of the fish they just caught prior to releasing it alive. All photographs are subject to approval by the ACFA Board of Directors for approval.

The members with the five longest "CPR" speckled trout will receive a special plaque recognizing their catch at the Awards Banquet in Dec.

This year Speckled Trout will be featured as a designated Tournament Species in all 9 tournaments. (plus the CPR awards).

Flounder is featured 7 times, Redfish 6 times, White Trout 5 times, Ground Mullet 3 times, and Blackfish and Spanish Mackerel two times.

Also we will offer up to 3 plaques for the special Open Pompano Division in the April Tournament (though NO tournament points) and an additional plaque to reward the angler in the August "Grand Slam" Tournament weighing in the heaviest "Grand Slam" (combined weight of that angler's Speckled Trout, Redfish, and Flounder) whether or not any or all of their "Grand Slam" fish place in the top 5 of those species.

NOTE: ANY angler placing in the top 5 of all 3 of the designated "Grand Slam" species for this tournament will still receive a bonus 5 Tournament Points. That's only been done 3 times in 10 years!

Additionally, a semi-anonymous benefactor has again made cash contributions to the club requesting those funds be used for the junior anglers. Last year we experimented with the idea of adding a separate Junior Angler species in EVERY tournament. That was interesting and fun, but...

This year we will offer the Junior Anglers plaques for 1st thru 3rd place in EACH of the designated species for EVERY tournament!

To avoid any confusion with the regular tournament point totals, NO points will be given for the Junior Angler species (except for one Tournament "Participation Point") unless the Junior Angler's fish is in the top 3 entries overall. (i.e. with the adults)

Example:

For the March Tournament the designated fish species are Speckled Trout, White Trout, Sheepshead and Ground Mullet.

Let's say the heaviest Sheepshead caught by a Junior Angler is also the 2nd heaviest overall.

That (Junior) Angler "passes" on the 1st place Junior Angler plaque (and NO points) for the 'more prestigious' 2nd place overall plaque (with the accompanying 2nd place points).

Then the Junior Anglers who landed the next 3 biggest sheepshead will all move up in order and get Junior Angler plaques.

So in this case 4 Junior Anglers would receive plaques instead of just 3.

In 2008 Junior Anglers will be offered plaques for 3 places for a different species in EVERY tournament throughout the year (up to 15 per tournament) for a total of up to 113 Junior Angler Plaques. This offers the greatest opportunity for the kids to fish right along with the adults.
