Catch, Photo and Release (CPR) Speckled Trout Contest Standing as of September 20, 2012

At least the top 5 place CPR Speckled Trout will receive plaques at the end of the year.

Keep in mind that EVERY participation point you earn in each of our 8 club tournaments gives you another chance in our 'PP Drawing' at the end of the year Awards Banquet (held in December).

ACFA is a local inshore saltwater fishing club. Meetings are held the first Thursday of each month to promote friendship, sportsmanship, and **conservation** along coastal Alabama.

New: NETMAN (or WOMAN) of the Year Category!

19. Any ACFA angler at the time of their weighing in a tournament fish who declares the eligible member or dependant who actually netted that fish for them (including themselves) will be awarded the same number of points in a separate category called "Netman of the Year". These points will be tallied and kept for the duration of the tournament season and the angler with the most accumulated "net" points will receive this award during the December Banquet.

NOTE: these point totals are entirely separate from the traditional Tournament Point Standings and have no bearing on the Tournament Points or Master Angler

Vince "Hawk" Hawkins

Vince Hawkins aka "hawk" is a lifelong resident of Mobile County. He grew up in Chickasaw, but spent most weekends on the creeks and lakes off the Tombigbee River around Bates Lake. He was fortunate enough to have a father that helped instill in him a love of the outdoors and spend time making memories that are with him even 35 years later. Vince graduated from Satsuma High School in 1988 and then the University of Montevallo in December of 1992.

He began working at CPSI in 1993 and has been there ever since. He has been married to his darling wife Dana for 18 years and they have two beautiful daughters (13 and 10).

Vince learned about the ACFA through the club's website and joined both in 2006. Until then he really only fished for flounder and Redfish/Specks were considered "bycatch". ACFA Guide's Tip of the Month

Making a good game plan by: Captain George Harrison



If you want to try and make sure you will have a successful trip and catch fish you have to start with a good game plan. Making a good game plan begins as much as a week in advance by thinking of where you will be fishing and maybe even picking the best day based on weather forecasts and other information available. I try to look at the weather daily and watch the tides and water clarity all through the week. Come fishing day, that helps me decide the most favorable locations. To me the wind is one of the biggest factors when it comes to choosing where I am going to fish. But be sure and have several alternate spots picked out in case the first few don't work for you.

Networking with other fishermen you know and trust (like in the ACFA) who have been fishing those areas doesn't hurt either. And last but not least always call the bait shops in advance the day before and see who has live bait. That is much better than when you get there and figure it out the hard way at 5 in the morning.
