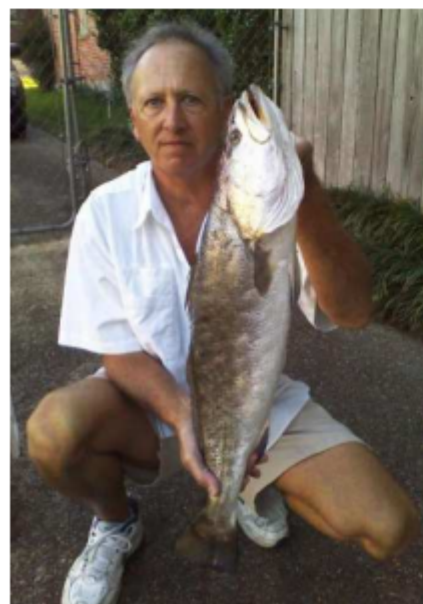
SPECKTAKULAR FIRST TOURNEY!
