ACFA August 'Mobile Bay Grand Slam' Tournament and Membership Shrimp Boil...

will be held on Saturday August 4th with the weigh-in from 3-5pm at (the usual place) the American Legion Post 250 on Dauphin Island Parkway just two drives south of the Greer's Foodtiger store.

The ACFA recognizes speckled trout, redfish, and flounder as the three species comprising a Grand Slam for Mobile Bay and its connecting waterways. Catching fish of all three species in a single day is considered a fine accomplishment among inshore fishers and to do it during a tournament is even finer. So to 'sweeten the pot' as it were the ACFA is awarding plaques and points for 5 places (1st through 5th) for these three species. In addition any angler who completes the Grand Slam **and places in each** of these three categories (1st -5th) will be awarded 5 additional (bonus) tournament points!

To the best of our knowledge this has only been accomplished three times since 1997, the last time was in 2004 by Bill Midgette. And new this year, the angler who weighs in the heaviest aggregate weight of the three Grand Slam species in the tournament will receive a special plaque of recognition for the feat, even if none of the fish place in their respective categories.

White trout and blackfish will be the other two species eligible for plaques and points (places 1st through 3rd) and the Junior anglers will have their own category in croaker where plaques will be awarded for places 1 through 5 (NO points for croakers though). But the total of 27 plaques makes this the biggest award cache in ACFA history! Good luck, fish hard and get your share of the action.

Also in appreciation of ALL our members, the ACFA is planning a Shrimp Boil 'feed' at the weigh-in site. All paid members, their spouses and children are invited to attend and partake in the boiled shrimp and other 'fixins'. Guests (as always) are welcome, but PLEASE if they are not eligible for ACFA benefits, please make a \$5 per person donation to help the club cover the cost.

Our food chairman Randy 'Bigun' Wiscaver could use some extra hands on the cooking crew, so consider volunteering your time and talents. You can approach Randy at the meeting (before, during or after) or call him at 662-3628, or just pitch in at the weigh in.

Hundreds of kids participated in **the Roy Martin Young Anglers Tournament** Saturday July 14th, and it was pointed out that several among the ones who finished at the top of the pack are children of ACFA members. Apparently, the specks were not cooperating for Cody Pierce (Butch's son) nor were the white trout, but he did snag first place and a potential Alabama State Record with his hardhead catfish that weighed 3.01#. And Alison Pierce (Mike's daughter) caught the third place hardhead catfish of 2.36#. And Keith McGraw's son Garrison brought in the first place ground mullet of 1.91# (bigger than any on the ACFA Big Fish Board so far ;-). Among the 'honorable mentions' of the many parents and caring adults who took kids fishing was George Koulianos who took a group of his son Theo's friends out on the charter boat Mar-T. In addition to them catching a fine box of fish, young Evangelos Savaides of Greece on his first fishing trip caught the second place triggerfish of 5.00#. They said he was "all smile."

This past weekend was the granddaddy of them all **the Alabama Deep Sea Fishing Rodeo**. There's no telling how many ACFA members fished in the tournament, and fished HARD. And more than a few members' names came and went on the leader board during the course of the weekend in what Vince "Hawk" Hawkins called "our 15 minutes of fame." But when it was all done two ACFA members' names remained: Vicki Foster 3rd place Black Drum 42.08# and Rick Tourne 3rd place Blackfish 20.50#. Way to go!!

A Storm Statement:

was added to our by-laws after 2005's busy hurricane season interrupted our schedule.

Let's hope bringing this up doesn't 'hex' us, but it seemed timely to republish it with the heart of the season upcoming.

"IF a named tropical storm or hurricane is predicted to strike the Gulf Coast within approximately 140 miles east or west of Mobile (including the area between New Orleans, LA and Panama City, FL) on or close to a scheduled ACFA Saturday tournament, that tourney will automatically be postponed until the following Saturday (unless that Saturday falls on the weekend of the Alabama Deep Sea Fishing Rodeo in which case it will be postponed 2 weeks later)."

Additional note: IF a hurricane is immediately threatening our area or a curfew is in effect in the City of Mobile (following a hurricane landfall) at the time of our scheduled monthly meeting, that meeting will be cancelled (and not rescheduled). All business pertinent to that meeting (plaque presentations, etc.) will be done at the next scheduled meeting the following month.

Hopefully, we won't have to implement this but we wanted everyone to be aware of our procedures in the event of a hurricane.
