Third Annual ACFA July Junk Sale

Start searching through your boat, auto, storage shed/garage, tackle boxes, closets, and back porch for anything (even remotely) connected with our sport that you don't really need anymore. It's time to see what the market will bear and maybe help our club in a small way. Operating under the old saying that "somebody's trash is surely someone else's

, easure" we afford you the opportunity to A) relieve yourself of some unwanted/unneeded items and make some money (to buy more stuff); B) obtain an item that you've wanted but couldn't afford to buy new; and C) produce a little money for our club treasury. Items for this sale can be large or small, short or tall, new or used, and don't worry about age or condition. Just price each item at whatever <u>you</u> can stand and we'll see if it can find a new home on Thurs. nite. Last year approx. \$600 changed hands and ACFA made slightly over \$60 on the evening.

Using the honor system we ask that each seller total up their gross sales for the evening and then deliver 10% of that total to our club treasurer Tom Duncan. Example: You sell an unwanted boat anchor for \$6.00 so you deliver \$0.60 to Tom. We <u>don't</u> <u>pretend</u> to make a lot of money from this junk sale--just enough to have some fun and help with future club projects. We <u>do</u> <u>depend</u> on the honest of you the individual member to get him that 10% (of your sales) to this treasurer

The sale begins at 6:30 or as soon as members get set up. Each member having items to sell (and we hope everyone does) should place them on the table at which you're sitting. This way members can browse the room without a jam-up and you can better tend to your sales. If possible, price each item where that amount can be easily seen by others.

Remember 1) Be sure to attend this meeting. 2) Get there early. 3) Bring something to sell. 4) Bring some spending (mad) money. And 5) Bring plenty of change and small bills.

First-Ever ACFA July Club Tournament

Due to popular demand we will have a July Tourney this year, but with a slight twist. The <u>speckled trout</u> category will be a team event with two-man teams entering a 5 fish creel. We've never attempted a creel event before so we'll see how this turns out. (By the way, if you don't have, or want, a partner a single angler can enter 5 fish by himself.) Plaques for first through third speckled trout creels will be awarded to both team members as will tournament points. This means not 12 but 15 plaques will be up-for-grabs. The other three tournament fish will be <u>Redfish</u>, <u>Flounder</u>, and <u>White Trout</u> and these species will be treated in our usual manner.

The name of this tourney is "Rodeo Warm-Up." Sat. July 3rd is the date. Weigh-in will be from 3-5pm at our usual location--behind the American Legion Post 250 on D.I.P.
